If you're at least 13 years old and you choose to **create a personal College Board student account**, you'll have access to personalized content for multiple programs and services.



MY PRACTICE

With a personal College Board student account, you can see results from any SAT® Suite practice test in My Practice. Each set of results has links to the following additional resources and information to help you practice more effectively:

- **Score details:** See every question on your practice test, including the correct answer, the answer you selected, and a Review button with a breakdown of each answer choice.
- **Review the test on Khan Academy®:** For official SAT practice tests, Khan Academy has matching review courses to walk you through each question. Not only can you read through a detailed answer explanation, but you can also jump to a lesson that covers the skills you need to answer similar questions in the future.
- **Practice Specific Questions:** My Practice gathers a tailored set of questions from our Student Question Bank based on your performance on each practice test to help you build your skills at a level that's right for you.
- **Download a practice score report:** Want to share your scores with your school counselor, teacher, or family member? Practice score reports provide a high-level summary of your performance on the practice test, including your total and section scores and the number of questions you answered correctly.
- **Student Question Bank:** Want even more questions focused on the areas where you need more practice? Use the Student Question Bank to filter, review, and download additional sets of practice questions for PSAT-related tests and the SAT. You'll be able to see your practice test score details alongside the question filters, so you can easily find questions in the content domains you need to work on the most, at the appropriate difficulty levels.

MY SAT

In My SAT, you can register to take the SAT on a weekend or make modifications to your existing weekend registration. You can also print your admission ticket before the test and order the *Official Digital SAT Study Guide* from the [College Board store](#).

When you take the SAT, you have the option to select up to 4 institutions to receive your scores for free. You can designate your score recipients (i) at the time you register, (ii) any time until you test, or (iii) within 9 days after you take a weekend test in My SAT. To order additional score sends for a fee, use the Student Score Report portal.



STUDENT SCORE REPORT PORTAL

The Student Score Report portal gives you online access to your scores from any test in the SAT Suite of Assessments, as well as additional insights like how your scores compare to other testers, your readiness for college or possible careers, and your progress toward mastery of the knowledge and skills (content domains) measured on the test. You can also use this portal to send SAT score reports to additional institutions for a fee.



STUDENT SEARCH SERVICE

A personal College Board student account also allows you to access Student Search Service™, a free, voluntary College Board service that helps college and scholarship programs find and get in touch with students that might be a good match. You can opt in or out of this service at any time. Students who are contacted by colleges through Student Search receive, on average, 29% more offers of college admission.
