Introduction Score reports provide current score information for each student who completed the PSAT ${ }^{\text {m" }} 8 / 9$ test administration at your school.

## New Developments

- In 2023-24, we discontinued reporting many student data fields in a continued effort to protect student data privacy. Given these changes, this 2024-25 data layout has been updated to remove these blank fields from the layout, resulting in a shorter layout where those data fields we continue to report in 2024-25 have shifted or moved when compared to the 2023-24 data layout. The following fields previously reported blank in the 2023-24 data layout have been deleted in the 2024-25 data layout:
- FOREIGN ADDRESS INDICATOR
- HOMESCHOOLED INDICATOR
- READING TEST, WRITING AND LANGUAGE TEST, AND MATH TEST QUESTION ITEM DATA (multiple fields)
- ALL STUDENT QUESTIONNAIRE FIELDS (multiple fields).
- We have also discontinued reporting Race/Ethnicity fields. Those fields were replaced with a filler field.
- We have included only relevant score and score related fields in the scores and percentiles fields for the Total, Reading and Writing section, and Math section. Score and percentile fields used to report scores relevant only to a paper PSAT 8/9 have been deleted since they are not relevant to a digital PSAT 8/9.
- We have updated the values reported in the Grade Level field to better align with how students are registered for the PSAT 8/9.
- We have also added fields to report student knowledge and skill performance in the Reading and Writing and Math sections, including performance in 4 content domains in Reading and Writing and 4 content domains in Math.


## Score Report Delivery and Data Access

This field indicates whether or not the reported scores can be used for guidance purposes only. If " $Y$ " is reported, these scores can only be used by states, districts, and schools for educational guidance purposes and shall not be reported to any other organizations.

The PSAT 8/9 contains 3 scores, including a total score, a Reading and Writing section score, and a Math section score. The total score is on a scale of 240-1440; Reading and Writing, and Math section scores are on a scale of 120-720.

These fields report a student's knowledge and skills performance in the Reading and Writing and Math sections, including performance in 4 content domains in Reading and Writing and 4 content domains in Math. One of 7 performance score bands are reported. Performance score bands divide the Reading and Writing and Math sections' score scales into ranges of score points broad enough to allow for meaningful generalizations to be drawn about successively higher levels of student performance demonstrated on the digital SAT Suite tests.

[^0]The PSAT 8/9 uses 4 percentile ranks. Nationally representative percentiles are derived via a research study sample of U.S. students in the student's grade (eighth or ninth), weighted to represent all U.S. students in that grade, regardless of whether they typically take the PSAT 8/9. User group percentiles are based on the actual performance of test takers on the PSAT 8/9. We additionally report state percentiles (for U.S.-based testers) and country percentiles that are based on actual performance of test takers on the PSAT 8/9 in a student's state and/or country.

College and Career Readiness Benchmarks (positions 731-732)

For the PSAT 8/9, college and career readiness benchmark indicators are included at the section-level scores. As shown in our research, benchmark attainment is related to many positive college outcomes and can be a useful tool in measuring the college readiness of high school students.

## AP Potential (positions 753-758)

AP Potential ${ }^{T M}$ fields will be populated based on the student's performance on the PSAT 8/9 assessment. AP Potential is calculated as follows:

For ninth graders, AP Potential is calculated for European History, World History, Art History, Human Geography, Computer Science Principles, and Seminar only.

For eighth graders, AP Potential is not calculated for any courses.
For those courses where AP Potential is not calculated, the field will be blank.
Note: The AP Potential reported in the K-12 score reporting portal is the same information provided to the student. Additional information on AP Potential can be found in the AP Potential Tool at appotential.collegeboard.org/app/ welcome.do.

Date of Report (positions 779-788)

This field indicates the date a student's score record was generated into the file. The date of report, like all other date fields, is in the YYYY-MM-DD format. It can be used to determine the most recent information when multiple records are created for the same student.
