

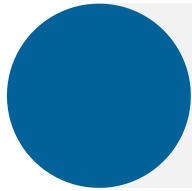

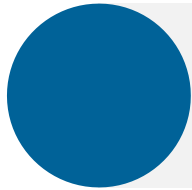

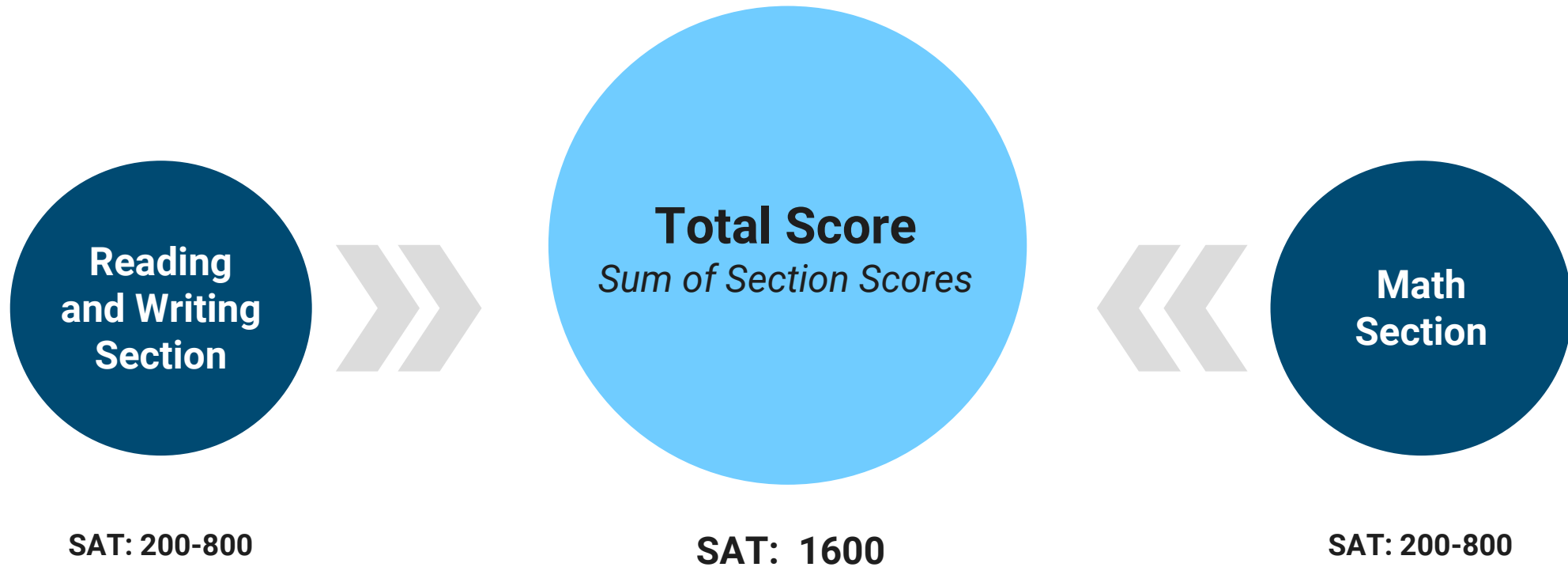

Student Scores on the SAT



- The SAT is on a 1600 point scale
 - 800 points are generated from the Reading and Writing Section and 800 from the Math section

SAT Suite College and Career Readiness Benchmarks

The tests in the SAT Suite of Assessments provide college and career readiness benchmarks and consistent feedback for measuring student progress.

- College and Career Readiness benchmarks
 - Set at the Section Level
 - Students who earn that score or higher have a 75% likelihood of earning a C or better in a first-year, credit-bearing course in the same subject area.
- Grade-level benchmarks
 - Based on expected student growth toward the SAT benchmark

Managing Access Tool (MAT)

- An access code is required to set up an Access Manager for the first time.
 - Call AP Educator Support at 877-274-6474 to request a Managing Access Tool access code if you have never had one generated

- Your institution's Access Manager is responsible for assigning K-12 Reporting Portal access to themselves and to their colleagues.
- **Reminder:** Access Managers should monitor access on a regular basis, removing access for those that no longer need it, or extending access for those whose access is about to expire.

Assigning Roles Using the MAT

- Access Managers use the Managing Access Tool to assign K-12 Reporting roles to individuals.
- The roles assigned determine the level of access granted. More than one role can be assigned:
 - **Access Management/DAT** – Responsible for managing access to their institution’s K-12 Reporting Portal using the Managing Access Tool.
 - **Detailed Reports** – Can run and view aggregate and student-level reports.
 - **Summary Reports** – Can run and view aggregate reports only.
 - **File Downloads** – Can view and download electronic score report (ESR) data files in the Downloads section of the K-12 Reporting Portal.



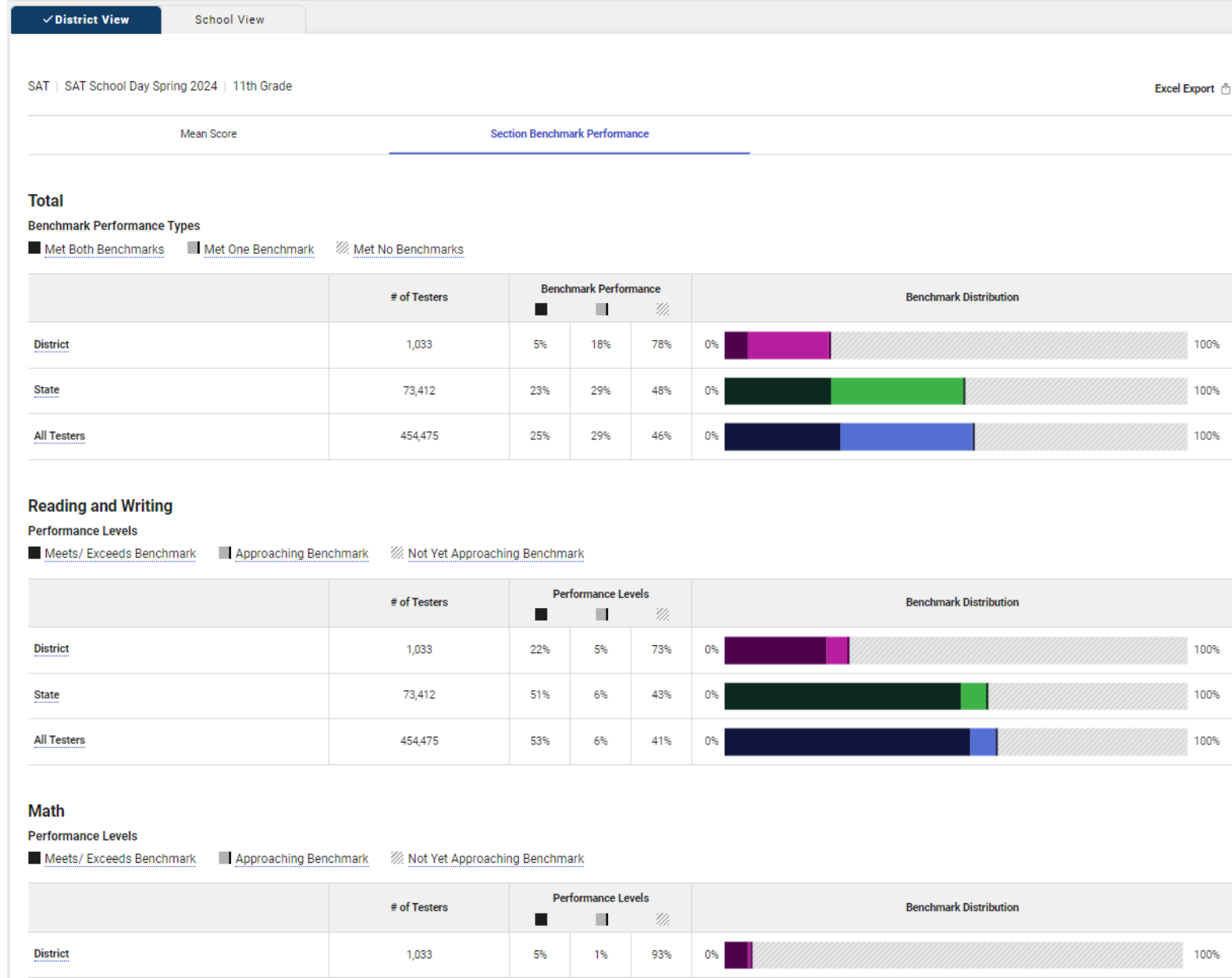
