SAT School Day

There are **12 steps** in the **Student Readiness Check** for **SAT School Day**.

□ Step 1 of 12 – Confirm Personal Information

Students Confirm Personal Information

- Confirm that your name and approved accommodations (if applicable) are listed. Then, click **Next**.
- **NOTE:** If your accommodations look inaccurate, let me know. We cannot continue with exam setup until all issues are resolved.

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


- On the first step of the Student Readiness Check you will be asked to confirm that your personal information is correct.
- Review the screen and make sure that the following information is right:
 - Your Name (First and Last)
 - Accommodations* (if you have any*)
 - If all the information is correct, click the yes button.
 - If no, raise your hand and let me know.

□ Step 2 of 12- Testing Rules




- On step two, you are going to read and agree to the Test Rules.
- This is an important agreement between you and College Board.
- The test rules are a legally binding contract, and there are serious consequences to not following them.
- Read each rule carefully.
- When you finish, click “Yes.”

□ Step 3 of 12- Big Future School



- On step three, you may enter your phone number to get the BigFuture School app.
- The BigFuture School app lets you view your scores and gain access to college and career resources.

□ Step 4 of 12 – Privacy Notice



- On step four, you will review and agree to the Privacy Notice.
- You will learn how College Board will protect your personal information.
- When you finish reading, click the “Yes” button.

Just like BigFuture School, Connections is free and optional. If you want to opt-in to Connections (which will allow you to get information about colleges, universities, and scholarship organizations), select the box that says "Yes, I want to participate in Connections" and click **Next**.

If you do not want to opt-in, do not select the box, and click **Next**.



- Click on the checkbox to sign up for Connections.

□ Step 10 of 12 – Send SAT Scores


Free Score Sends in Bluebook

- Students will be able to request where to send their four free SAT *School Day* scores sends as part of Exam Set-Up.
- Score send requests can be changed until three days after the student takes the test in Bluebook.
 - Students will need to use their School Day sign-in ticket credentials to access Bluebook if they would like to add or change score send requests after testing is completed.



- On step ten, you can choose up to four colleges, universities, and scholarships to send your scores.
- Make your selections.
- This step is *optional*.

□ Step 11 of 12 - Test Day Checklist




- On step eleven, you will see valuable information about:
