Test Day Toolkit (TDTK) is the web application used for the digital SAT administration. Coordinators will use TDTK to set up and prepare for testing. Test Day staff will use TDTK to administer and monitor testing. Test Day Toolkit can be accessed on any device that connects to the internet.

Overview of the Interactive Checklist

The Interactive Checklist is designed to help coordinators stay on track as they prepare for the Spring 2025 SAT School Day test administration. Over the coming months, School Test Coordinators will receive emails alerting them to key tasks and deadlines pertinent to spring testing. Each email will include directions for completing the task along with a completion deadline

to help coordinators manage their schedules. The School Test Coordinator will be responsible for sharing relevant tasks with SSD Coordinators, Technology Coordinators, and other test staff, if applicable. Coordinators will receive an introductory email about the Interactive Checklist mid-November.

SAT School Day is a partnership between College Board and the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce.
