College Board AI Code Confirmation Email: January 8, 2025

School Test Coordinators (STCs) and Principals will receive an email on January 8, 2025, which will serve as confirmation that your school is prepared to administer the SAT School Day. This email will include the school's AI code and School Test Coordinator information.
