



What is a **Module** of the Digital SAT School Day?

Each Section of the digital SAT School Day is composed of two Modules:



NOTE: This set-up is called "multi-stage" adaptive. As opposed to "item" adaptive testing, students can go back to prior questions within a module, and the test adapts based upon a greater amount of student performance information than a single response.

- Command of Evidence

- Inferences

 Measures comprehension, analysis, and reasoning skills and knowledge and the ability to locate, interpret, evaluate, and integrate information and ideas from texts and informational graphics (tables, bar graphs, and line graphs)

Standard English Conventions

- Boundaries
- Form, Structure, and Sense

 Measures the ability to edit texts to conform to core conventions of Standard English sentence structure, usage, and punctuation

Expression of Ideas

- Rhetorical Synthesis
- Transitions

 Measures the ability to revise texts to improve the effectiveness of written expression and to meet specific rhetorical goals

 Measures the ability to analyze, fluently solve, and create linear equations and inequalities as well as analyze and fluently solve equations and systems of equations using multiple techniques.

Algebra

- Linear equations in one variable

- Linear inequalities in one or two variables

Advanced Math

- Equivalent expressions
- Nonlinear equations in one variable and systems of equations in two variables

 Measures skills and knowledge central for progression to more advanced math courses, including demonstrating an understanding of absolute value, quadratic, exponential, polynomial, rational, radical, and other nonlinear equations.

 Measures the ability to apply quantitative reasoning about ratios, rates, and proportional relationships; understand and apply unit rate; and analyze and interpret one- and two-variable data.



 Measures the ability to solve problems that focus on area and volume; angles, triangles, and trigonometry; and circles





Ohio SAT School Day Testing Window: Spring 2025

Testing Window: March 3 – April 30

- > The SAT provides the most flexibility for districts and schools in planning their administration.
- ➤ Registering students can be completed just prior to when a district/school wants to administer the test.
- > There are two retest opportunities for students in the event there is a disruption that occurs during testing.
- ➤ While most students can test on a computer, paper testing is provided when it is required by a student's accommodation needs, access to technology is prohibited for safety or security reasons, or religious beliefs.
- ➤ The Bluebook testing application provides a variety of universal tools for students and is automatically configured when accommodations are needed by students.







These statements describe what students scoring in particular performance score bands on the Reading and Writing and Math sections of the digital SAT Suite tests are typically able to demonstrate.




Exemplar Test Questions


