FOR MOST STUDENTS, NO NEED TO PLUG IN:

99% of students who have taken the digital SAT lasted the full exam without needing to connect to power. For the few who ran out of battery, they were able to plug in and successfully complete testing.



DON'T SHELL OUT FOR EXTRA STORAGE SPACE:

Devices only need **250MB** of memory to run the digital assessments, or about as much storage as you'd need to download **50 songs** online.



LOW BANDWIDTH? NO PROBLEM:

Each student needs about **100Kbps** of bandwidth to take the test, or about as much as it would take to send **one text message**.



INTERRUPTED INTERNET ISN'T AN ISSUE:

Students need to connect to the internet to start the exam and submit their answers. If the internet drops during the test, **students can continue testing without disruption**.



SHORTER TEST = SHORTER TEST DAY:

The digital SAT Suite tests are just **over two hours long**, making test day shorter.
